## OVERVIEW

The Young Professionals Advisory Board (YPAB) is a diverse group of emerging leaders, between the ages of 21 and 35 years old, coming together to support My Life My Choice's fight for a world where no one is bought or sold. Through this new volunteer initiative, young professionals are joining My Life My Choice to expand its community and engage lifelong advocates dedicated to creating awareness and shifting minds about the Commercial Sexual Exploitation of Children.

## STRUCTURE

The Young Professionals Advisory Board is led by an executive committee composed of the President, Vice-President, Secretary and a Staff Representative.

Additionally, board members can get involved with one or more committees of their choice. Each committee is led by a chair who ensures smooth functioning and acts as a representative when necessary.

## COMMITTEES



### EVENTS COMMITTEE

- Manage planning and execution of young professionals' events.
- Assist with My Life My Choice events, as needed.



### OUTREACH COMMITTEE

- Work to increase awareness among other young professionals.
- Assist with general My Life My Choice outreach and fundraising.



### ADVOCACY COMMITTEE

- Support My Life My Choice in legislative and education efforts.
- Work to engage young professionals in those efforts.

# COMMITMENT & BENEFITS

## Board Members:

Board members commit to the YPAB for staggered terms of two or three years based the position. Throughout the commitment, board members serve an average of five hours monthly. Other obligations include:

- Attend quarterly YPAB meetings.
- Attend respective committee meetings.
- Participate in planning and attending annual young professionals' events.
- Support My Life My Choice fundraising efforts.
